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RICCI RESCUES IN THE PARK DRAWS HUNDREDS IN GREENVILLE DEBUT, RESULTING IN DOZENS OF ADOPTIONS

GREENVILLE, NC — Ricci Law Firm's Ricci Rescues in the Park held its first Greenville event on Saturday, June 13, 2026, at Wildwood Park, drawing hundreds of community members, helping dozens of animals find homes and generating adoption interest for many more. The free event was the second installment of the series, following the inaugural Ricci Rescues in the Park held in Raleigh last September. The Greenville event marked a special milestone for Ricci Law Firm, bringing the community initiative to the city where the firm was founded nearly 30 years ago.

More than a dozen local rescue organizations participated, bringing adoptable cats, dogs, kittens, and small animals. Among the notable adoptions: Sun Dancer, a cat featured through Ricci Law Firm's ongoing Ricci to the Rescue series, in which the firm sponsors \$100 toward the adoption fee for a local animal in need, found her forever home at the event, as did Rocky from Paws and All Feline Rescue, another sponsored cat from the series. Every kitten Winter's Grace Animal Rescue brought was adopted, along with all guinea pigs, one young rat, and one dog. One puppy entered a foster-to-adopt placement, and several rescue organizations received adoption applications.

"Ricci Law Firm was born in Greenville, and this community has supported us for nearly 30 years," said Brian Ricci, founder of Ricci Law Firm. "Bringing Ricci Rescues in the Park here wasn't a question. Seeing local families connect with rescue organizations and give animals a second chance made this event incredibly rewarding. We're already looking forward to another event."

Participating rescue organizations included Feline Freedom Society, Paws and All Feline Rescue, Pitt County Animal Services, Winter's Grace Animal Rescue, Wild Serenity Cat Rescue Fund, Beare Garden Animal Rescue, Lacey's Legacy Cat Rescue, Noah's Ark Pet Rescue, Pitt Friends, Pawfect Match Rescue and Rehabilitation, and Humane Society of Eastern Carolina.

In addition to adoption opportunities, attendees enjoyed local food trucks, family-friendly activities, pet-focused vendors, and educational resources from participating rescue organizations. The event was designed to raise awareness for animal adoption while strengthening connections between local rescues and the communities they serve.

The firm extends its thanks to all rescue groups, volunteers, vendors, and attendees. Organizers are already preparing for the second annual Ricci Rescues in the Park in Raleigh later this fall.
